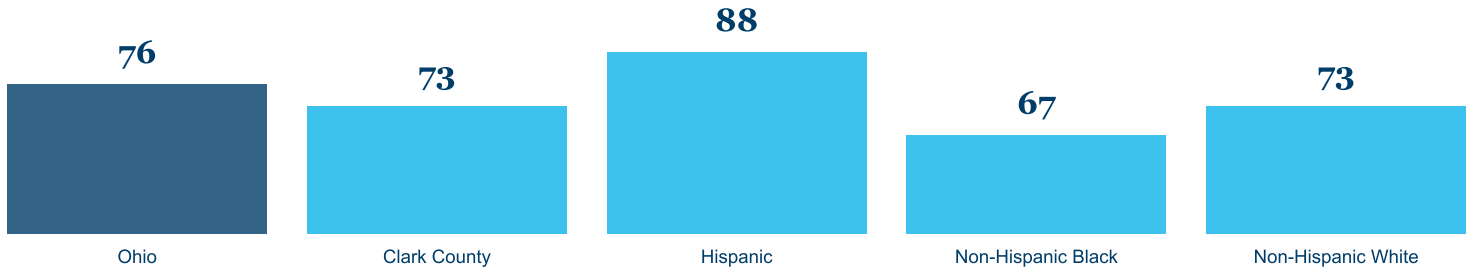

Clark Co. Broken Out By Race

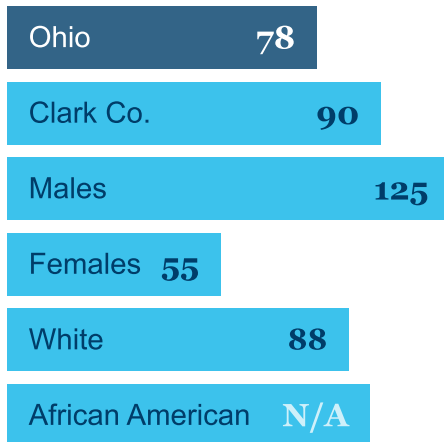

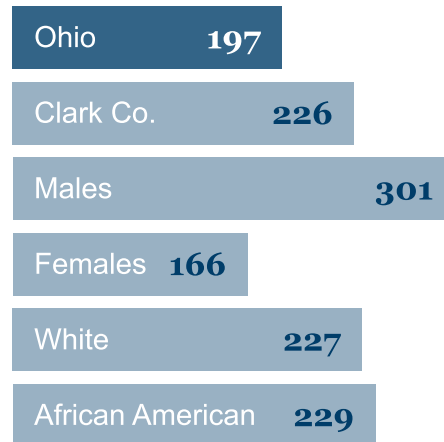

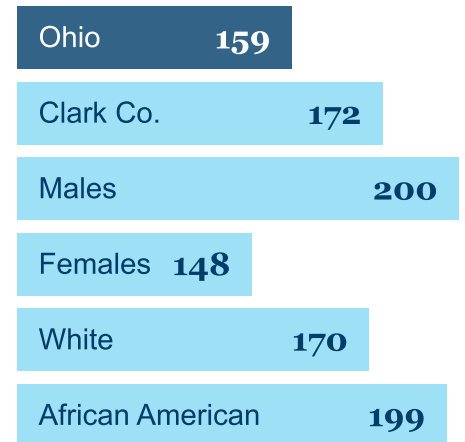

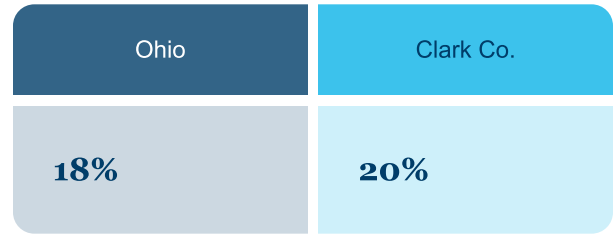

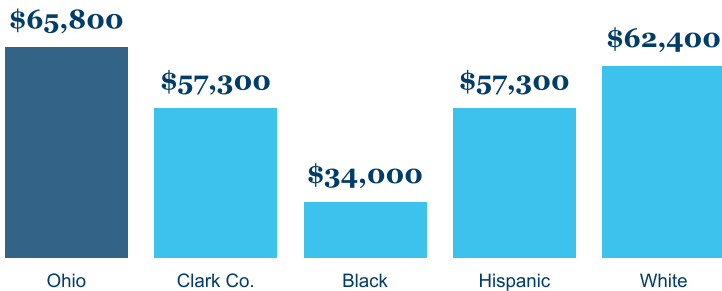

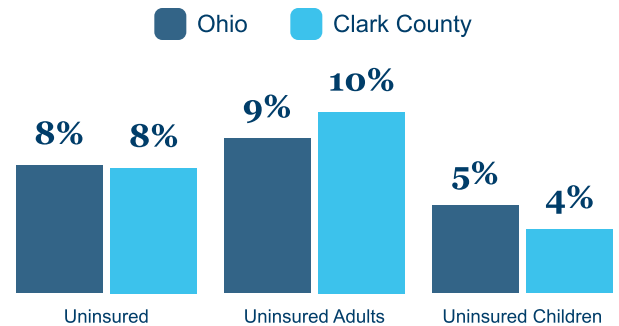
