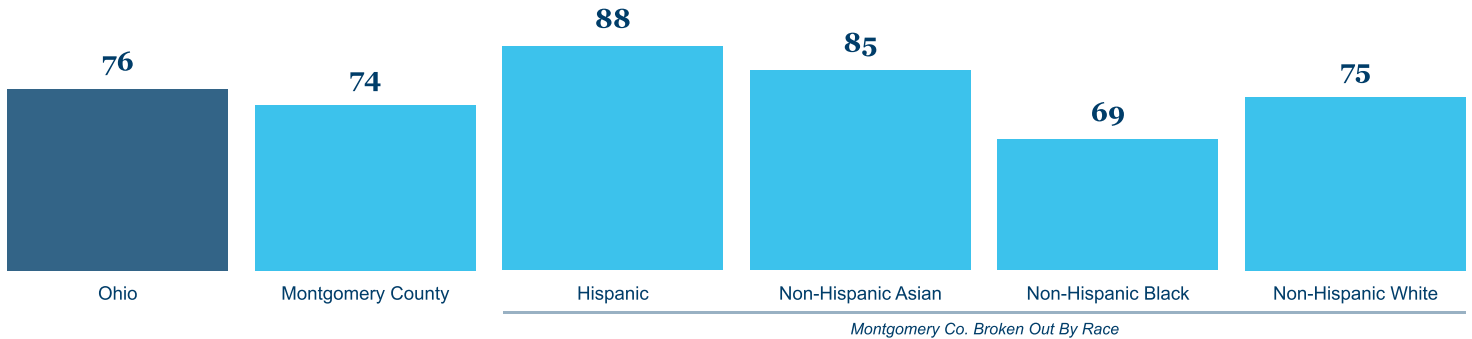

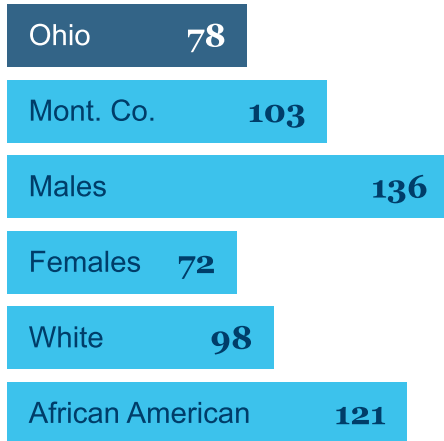

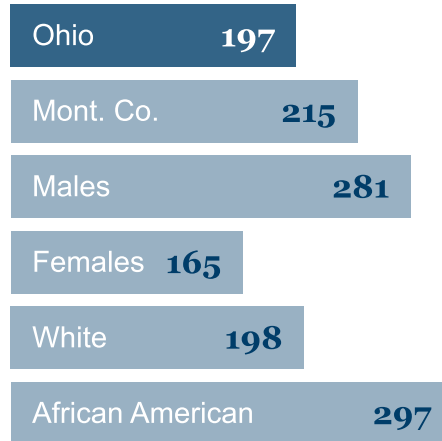
## Cause of Death Summary Age-Adjusted Mortality Rates

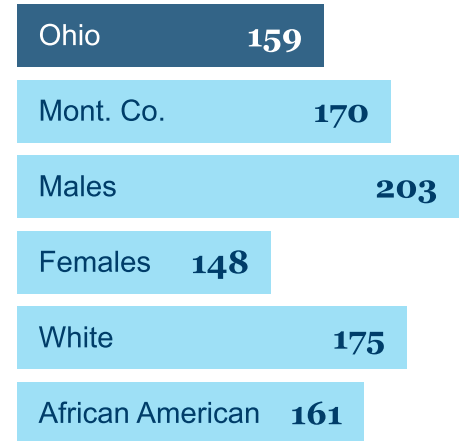

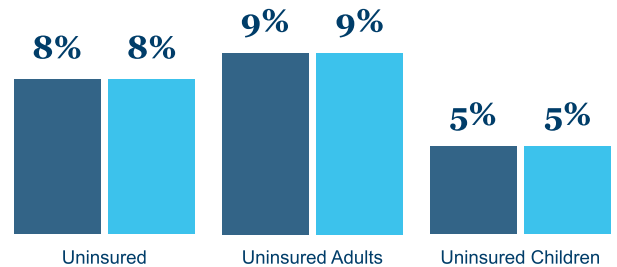

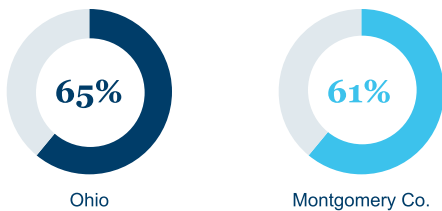


17 **Drug Overdose Death Rates**
